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Note! The AdvanceCall™ Box Integrated System requires an activation onto the CDMA or GSM Network. To arrange for activation onto the CDMA or GSM Network contact your local CDMA or GSM Provider sales representative or retail store.



■ SETTING UP THE CALLBOX FLUSH MOUNT™

- 1. Remove AdvanceCall Box Flush Mount from the package.
- 2. Plug the power supply into the wall AC power outlet and the barrel plug at the end of the cord of the power supply into the corresponding power receptacle on the bottom back of the AdvanceCall BoxTM
- 3. Plug the CDMA/GSM Antenna into the CDMA/GSM corresponding antenna receptacle on the bottom back of the AdvanceCall Box™
- 4. For optional installations *SEE OPTIONAL SETTINGS below.
- **5.** Place AdvanceCall Box to the desired spot where the Call Box will be installed and tighten into place with screws. (Screws not provided.) [Diagram 2]

■ OPTIONAL SETTINGS CALLBOX FLUSH MOUNT™

- **GPS Antenna** GPS Antenna can be installed in the receptable labeled GPS, for GPS feature. (GPS antenna sold seperately.)
- **RJ45** RJ45 is to install other accesories such as a Handset. (Accesories not provided)
- **IO PORT UTILITY This port is to install other features such as open doors and more. (Can be only be programmed and activated by AdvanceTec.)
- FLASHING LIGHT Connect flashing light accesory into this port. (Flashing ligh sold seperately.)
- **BACK UP BATTERY** Connect the Back Up Battery into this receptable for emergency outages, and continues power for up 8hrs.
- **USB UPGRADE PORT This port can only used by AdvanceTec engineers to program the numbers provided by the customer or to update the Call Box when necessary.

DIAGRAM1 *BACK UP CDMA/GSM *IO PORT BATTERY **POWER ANTENNA** UTILITY PORT ADAPTER







DIAGRAM 2

■ OPERATING THE ADVANCECALL™ BOX FLUSH MOUNT

- **1.** To make a call to the number initially programmed by AdvanceTec into the AdvanceCall Box press the **SEND** button and speak towards the microphone.
- **2.** The call will end once the person receiving the call hangs up or cancels the call.
